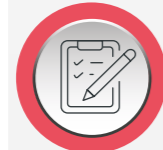

School life

IGCSE- and A-Level-programme

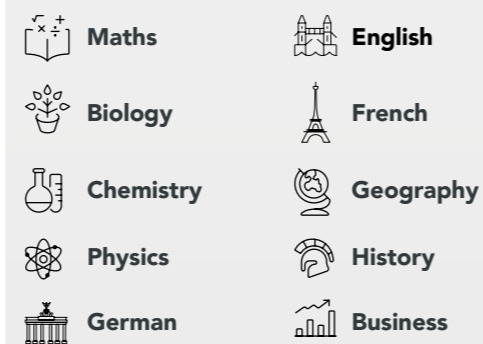
The transfer to our English-speaking short-term Gymnasium takes place after the second or third year of secondary school. Instead of an entrance exam, the family is invited to an entrance interview.

In Years 9 and 10, our students study a broad range of six to ten subjects culminating in their IGCSE examinations. The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is the world's most popular international curriculum for secondary education and provides students with an internationally recognised certificate.

In Years 11 and 12, students generally concentrate on three to four subjects which they study in depth, leading towards the International A Levels, thus gaining entry to colleges and universities worldwide.

All subjects are completed individually and can be repeated as often as desired.

Academic subjects



Study time

During the daily study time, students do their homework, receive additional material and exercises or focus on preparing their upcoming exams. They are closely attended to by our specialist teachers.

German Booster

Students whose mother tongue is not German but who would like to study at a Swiss university later on or integrate even better in Switzerland can book additional German lessons with us.

Project weeks and learning coach

During our project weeks, our specialist teachers work closely together to give our students interdisciplinary access to practice. This allows students to deal intensively with the topic chosen and apply the principles and theories they have learned in class.

A personal learning coach is provided for each student. In regular meetings, the coach covers with the student topics that go far beyond the actual imparting of knowledge in a specific subject, such as developing individual learning techniques and dealing with exam anxiety before or during an exam.

Electives and extracurricular activities

In addition to our regular classes, we offer a variety of electives and extracurricular activities. Our students can pursue their interests and passions and get involved in the school community. We encourage all students to select at least one non-examined extracurricular activity.

Our practice-orientated project and lab days are fixed features of our programme. In addition, our student council provides a spaces where our students have a voice. The student council can create student-driven initiatives, promote charitable work, or make suggestions for the improvement of our school.

We round off our extracurriculars with regular school field trips, culture days, cinema evenings and end-of-year parties which are co-organised by the students.
