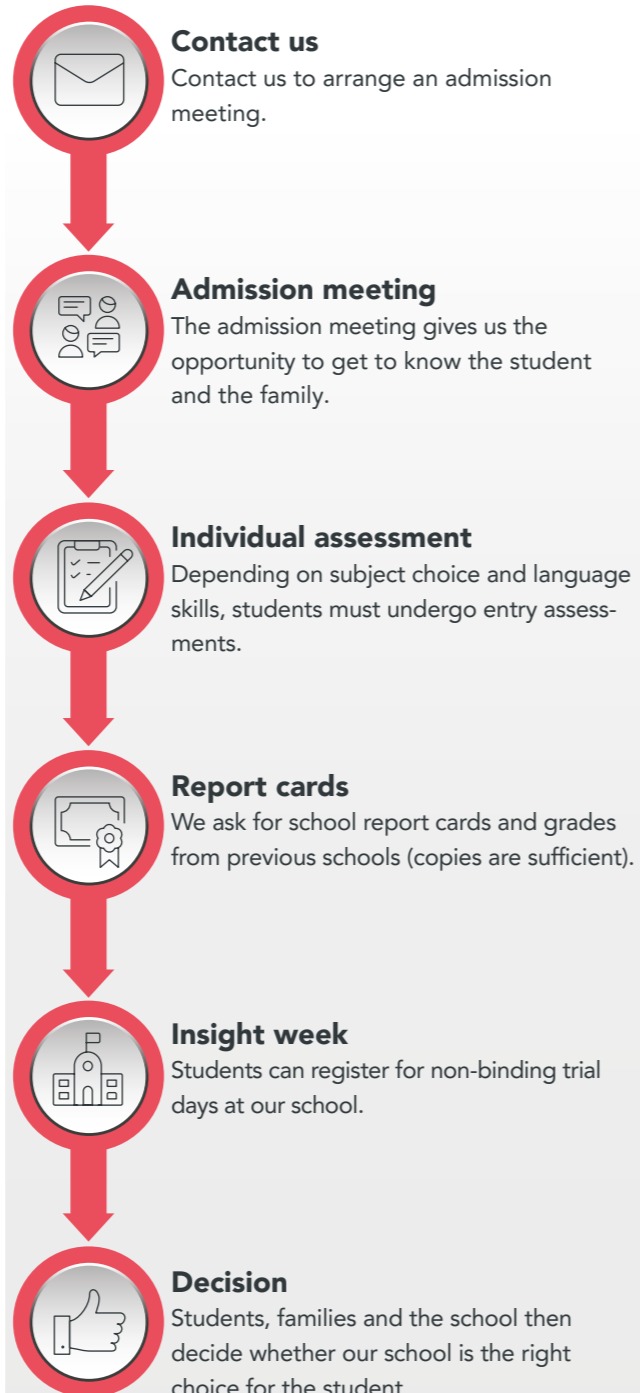

Our lower secondary school in Years 7 and 8 (Pre-IGCSE) provides a unique curriculum blending the well-established British International Cambridge Curriculum with a highly innovative and unique approach to German following the curriculum of the Canton of Zurich (Lehrplan 21). All academic subjects are taught in English; however, a considerable part of our teaching time is dedicated to German by layering our curriculum with project-based learning.

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is the world's most popular international curriculum for secondary education and provides students with an internationally recognised certificate.

In Years 11 and 12, students generally concentrate on three to five subjects which they study in depth, leading towards the A Levels, thus gaining entry to colleges and universities worldwide.

Study time

During the study time, which is offered several times a week, students do their homework, receive additional material and exercises or focus on preparing their upcoming exams. They are closely attended to by our specialist teachers.

Project weeks

During our project weeks, our specialist teachers work closely together to give our students interdisciplinary access to practice. This allows students to deal intensively with the topic chosen and apply the principles and theories they have learned in class.

Wellbeing and Learning Coaching

Our School Counsellor serves as a trusted advisor to our students, offering comprehensive support in all aspects of their academic and personal lives. In addition to emotional and social guidance, our School Counsellor provides targeted learning coaching, assists in developing effective learning strategies, and supports the organisation of daily school routines. Through regular workshops, we foster the development of our students, strengthening their self-confidence and resilience.

Careers Advisor

Our Careers Advisor assists our students in making informed decisions about study opportunities in Switzerland and abroad, exploring potential career paths, and obtaining general information about universities. 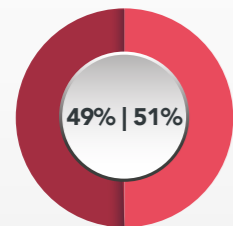

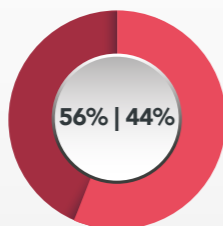
Our students

As an international school following an English-speaking curriculum, many of our teachers have QTS (Qualified Teacher Status) and are experienced UK teachers. A high proportion of our teachers are educated to Master's level in education or hold a doctoral degree in their subject area.
